The Board will put this on the agenda for the Annual Meeting on March 14, 2017, therefore the residents of Belle Plaine Township can determine if they want to spend their money to repave Laredo Avenue.

Jeff Klehr is working on the culvert/road issues on Laredo Avenue. In the meantime we need to get the brick mailboxes removed so he is able to start digging to determine the exact issue is. The residents were also informed once the brick mailboxes are removed they will need to install breakaway or swing away posts since Belle Plaine Township has adopted the state & federal requirements for mailbox installations and/or supports.

Kristy will send a copy of the meeting minutes from May 2, 2000 to Dale Stier that stated Leroy Chard was present to request that he could tar by the Golf Course in Belle Plaine Township. It would be a 24’ of tar with gravel sides. If he goes to the clubhouse it would be 900 feet. If he got the maintenance building it would be 1800 feet. It would be a 2 inch base with 1 ½ ware. If it breaks up he will have to improve it or remove it.
